Keiser University paid \$25 million to acquire Northwood University's West Palm Beach campus, according to county records. The campus, located at 2600 Military Trail, sits on a 100-acre site with 263,968 square feet of buildings. Keiser University stated that the acquisition of its second West Palm Beach campus was made possible by a \$10 million donation.
